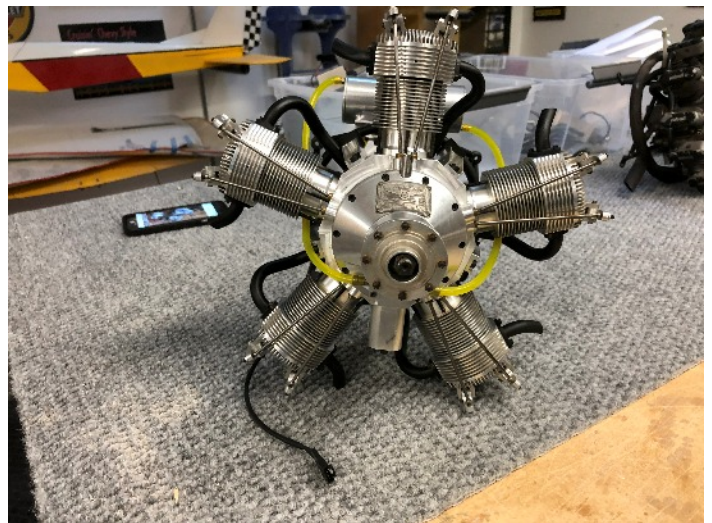

Ray English made an interesting presentation of the various radial engines he has been modifying for his clients all over the world.

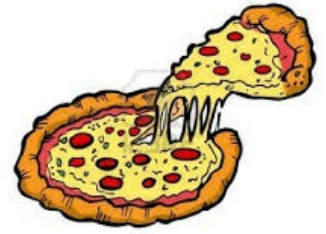
It is amazing how his business had developed from doing someone a favor and the word spreading. Good job, Ray.

August 2, 2018

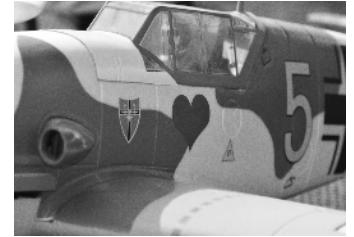
- I. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Jim Kelso. Fourteen members and guests were present.
