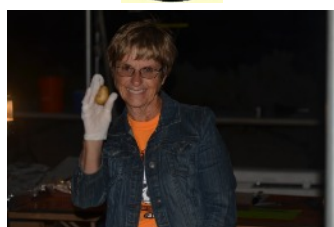

"Smokey the Bear" and his "Wrangler Crew"

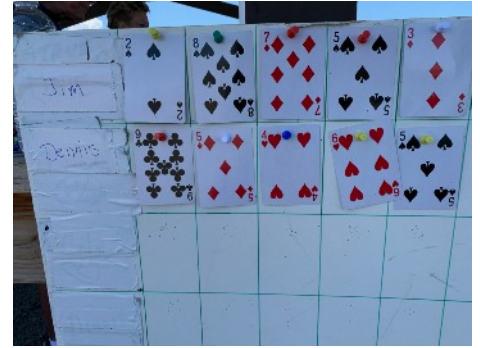
